

Won't You Be My Neighbor? Apr 21 - Who is my Neighbor?

CONNECT

Spend some time checking in. What are highs and lows since you last met? How can your group members pray for and support each other this week?

GROW

- What did you like or not like about the stories you heard from the Civil Rights Tour Group? Did you learn anything new?
- How do people get their information today? How is news distributed?
- The struggle for people of color in the deep south is part of all of our histories, yet so many of us did/do not know the full extent of African American's history in the United States. How does it make you feel that many Americans (just like you) have experienced horrific abuse based on their race?
- In Luke 10, Jesus tells the story of a man who was in need of help, and two religious people went out of their way to <u>not</u> help the man. When someone else - an unlikely servant - helped the man, Jesus says that this man was "a neighbor" to the injured man. What are ways that we can be good neighbors to people in need?
