Guest Speaker – Nicholas Tangen

Nicholas Tangen is a writer, coach, and congregational organizer in Minneapolis, MN. He is a graduate of United Theological Seminary and works as the Director of Faith Practices & Neighboring Practices at the Minneapolis Area Synod of the ELCA.

As part of the Thriving Congregations project funded by the Lilly Endowment, Nick is leading a new emphasis at the synod, the combination of faith and neighboring practices. His previous experiences in congregations include serving as the Minister of Faith in Community at University Lutheran Church of Hope (ULCH), near the University of Minnesota campus in Minneapolis, and a stint on the staff at Gustavus Adolphus Lutheran in Northeast Minneapolis, where he helped guide a revamping of its children's ministry.

Nick grew up in Rosemount, Minnesota, and attended the School of Environmental Studies on the Minnesota Zoo property. He studied English at the University of Minnesota, and graduated with a Master of Arts in Leadership degree, with a focus in Social Transformation, from United Theological Seminary.

A Benedictine Oblate at St. John's Abbey in Collegeville, Nick is passionate about contemplative and monastic spirituality.

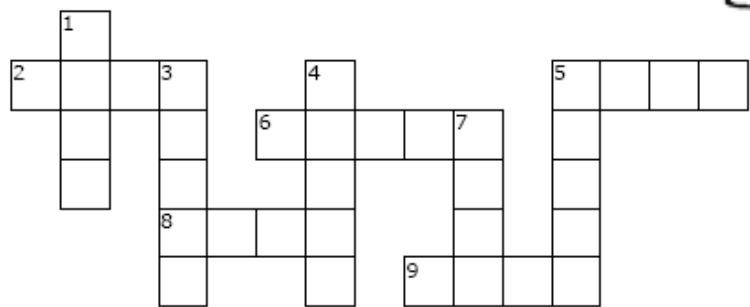
