- There will be some savings because the church building is not being used.
- Giving statements will go out the first week of May with a letter from Pastor Nathan.
- A piece of property has been gifted to the church.

### Pastor's report

The staff is working from home except for the broadcasts. Linda and Lori do come in a couple days a week to count offerings and complete items that cannot be done from home.

- The Community Care Team, of 15-20 people, have called 232 households. They have about 100 more to call.
- The Genesis and other Bible Studies will be offered online. Staff is looking at ways to connect with people.
- The staff is beginning to discuss what a gradual return to in-person worship and congregational life may look like.
