Lutheran Social Services of Minnesota (LSSMN) Refugee Services **Matching Gift Challenge**

Lutheran Social Services of Minnesota has a long history of serving neighbors in a variety of ways, including the unique needs of refugees relocating to Minnesota. There are 25.4 million refugees worldwide. A refugee is any person, living outside of his or her home country, who is unable to return to their home country due to a well-founded fear of persecution based on race, religion, nationality, membership in a particular social group or political opinion. Less than one half of 1% of the world's refugees each year find a safe haven through resettlement in another country. Those who are lucky enough to find safety and a new start in another country wait an average of 17 years in refugee camps. The work of LSSMN is the work of the church, helping refugees secure housing and find employment, enroll in school and English classes, connect to medical care, orient to their community and build bridges across cultures.

On Easter Sunday we are kicking off a six week appeal to collect funds to support LSSMN's work with refugees. Thanks to the generous commitment of one of our members all gifts up to \$5000 will be matched dollar for dollar. We have a great opportunity to help some of our newest neighbors. I hope you'll support this effort to **Be the Church!**
