



PASTOR MARK HANSON

ELCA presiding bishop emeritus

Pastor Hanson presided over the 2009 ELCA Churchwide Assembly that voted to allow the ELCA to ordain LGBTQ clergy and congregations to call them. We are thrilled to welcome Bishop Hanson to Elk River Lutheran Church to witness this joyful, accepting community that was born out of the conflict from that controversial vote.

Before being elected presiding bishop, he served as bishop of the Saint Paul Area Synod (3H). Prior to being elected synod bishop, he served as pastor of three Minnesota congregations: Prince of Glory Lutheran Church, Minneapolis; Edina Community Lutheran Church, Edina, Minn., and University Lutheran Church of Hope, Minneapolis.

From 2003 until 2010, he was president of the Lutheran World Federation, a position he held concurrently with his position as presiding bishop of the ELCA. Serving with this global communion of Lutheran churches, Bishop Hanson has traveled widely throughout the world, sharing a confident hope in God's promises and a vision of the joyful freedom in Christian community and mission.

Married to Ione (Agrimson), they are the parents of Aaron, Alyssa, Rachel, Ezra, Isaac and

Elizabeth, and grandparents to Naomi, Kingston, Sam, Danielle, Sophia and Remi. Before moving to Chicago, Ione was the director of social work at Minneapolis and St. Paul Children's Hospitals.

Pastor Hanson's primary vocation is to accompany lone on their shared journey as lone lives with advanced memory loss. He also is serving as a Fellow at the Augsburg University Interfaith Institute.
