Spend some time checking in. What are highs and lows since you last met? How can your group members pray for and support each other this week?


GROW

- Martin Luther described us all as simultaneously saint and sinner. How does this understanding shape how we see ourselves, the people in our lives, and loved ones who have died?
- Read Hebrews 12:1-2
 - Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, 2 looking to Jesus, the pioneer and perfecter of faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God.
- Who are the saints of God, living or dead, who are a part of your "cloud of witnesses"? (People who have been there for you through thick and thin, shown up in times of great need, and provided encouragement.)
- What does it look like for you to "run with perseverance the race" set before you at this age and stage of your life?




