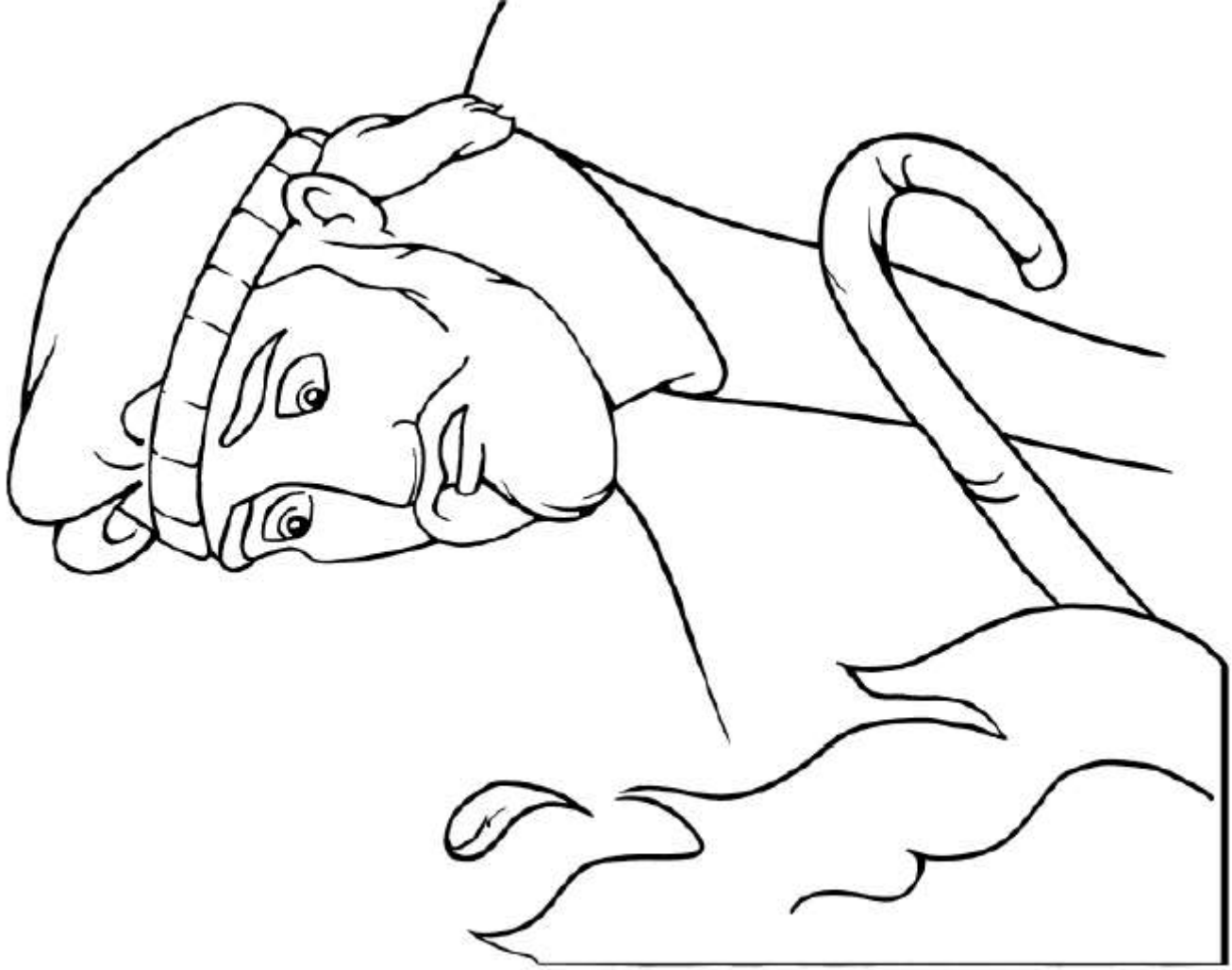
Linda's Out for a Special Celebration!

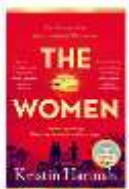

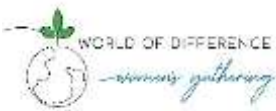
Join Us for the World of Difference Women's Gathering
