### The Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross is a devotional practice that consists of 14 stations, each one standing for an event that occurred in the passion of Jesus. The stations grew out of imitations of *Via Dolorosa* in Jerusalem which is believed to be the actual path Jesus walked to Mount Calvary. The object of the stations is to help make a spiritual pilgrimage through contemplation of the *Passion of Christ*. Art, combined with literature, prayer and reflection assist us as we work our way through this devotion.


#### 14 Stations of the Cross

- 1. Jesus is condemned to death
- 2. Jesus takes up his Cross
- 3. Jesus falls a first time
- 4. Jesus meets his afflicted mother
- 5. The Cross is laid on Simon of Cyrene
- 6. A woman wipes the face of Jesus
- 7. Jesus falls a second time
- 8. Jesus meets the women of Jerusalem
- 9. Jesus falls a third time
- 10. Jesus is stripped of His garments
- 11. Jesus is nailed to the Cross
- 12. Jesus dies on the Cross
- 13. The body of Jesus is placed in the arms of His mother
- 14. Jesus is laid in the tomb
