



GOSPEL READING: Mark 16:1-8

The resurrection of Jesus is announced, and the response is one of terror and amazement.

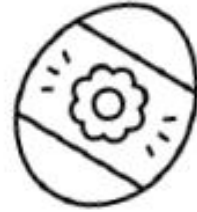

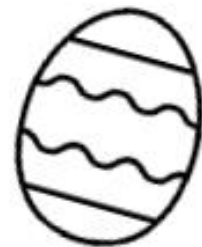

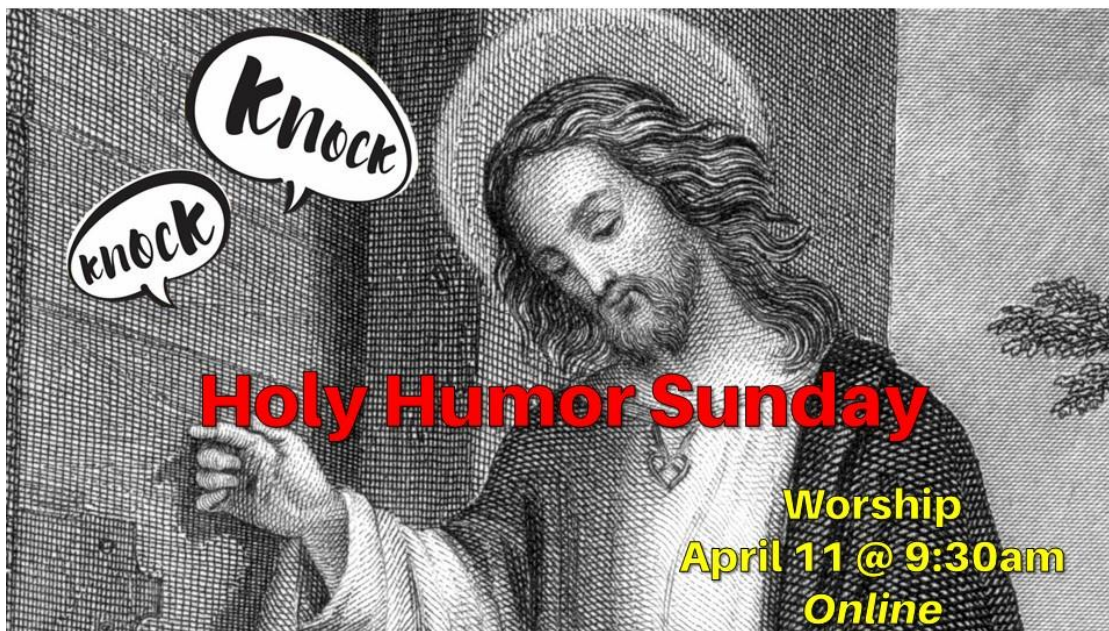
