

This is being sent on short notice, but any help you can give in spreading the word to your congregation about an upcoming COVID vaccine clinic would be appreciated. Appointments are available.

Sherburne County Health & Human Services is offering a Moderna COVID-19 vaccination clinic at the Government Center in Elk River, for residents age 65 and older, **Friday February 26th**.

There are limited appointment slots available. **You must have an appointment to attend clinic.** Anyone unable to show proof of age (i.e. photo id) will be turned away at clinic check-in.

If you are not able to schedule an appointment, we will notify you when other opportunities arise.

DO NOT SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT IF:

- You are age 64 years or younger.
- If you are not available to receive your 2nd dose on Friday, March 26th.
- You have been exposed to COVID-19 and will be in quarantine during the clinic date.
- You are positive for COVID-19 and may be in isolation during the clinic date.
- You have had any vaccine administered in the 14 days prior to the clinic date.

Schedule your appointment -

- The scheduling links will close at end of day on 2/25/21. Please schedule your appointment as soon as possible. Try using Chrome as the web browser if you are having issues with Internet Explorer
- When you get to the 'Health Insurance' screen, choose **"No Insurance"** in the 'Insurance Type' dropdown.
- Once your appointment is scheduled, you will receive a confirmation email from "Vaccination Clinics". If you don't see this in your Inbox then be sure to check your Junk mail.
- If needed, you can reschedule or cancel your appointment from links at the bottom of your confirmation email.

The day of your appointment -

Sherburne County Government Center

- Address: 13880 Business Center Drive NW, Elk River, MN. Park in the main parking lot
- Enter Door A (near the flag poles). Look for the Registration table in the main lobby upon entering Door A
- Arrive at your appointment time.
- You should be feeling well. If not, cancel your appointment and contact covid@co.sherburne.mn.us or 763-765-4156 to reschedule.
- Before coming to your appointment, be sure to have something to eat.
- Bring photo identification that also has your date of birth.
- Wear a shirt that allows easy accessibility to your upper arm. A short-sleeved is great!
- You will be asked a series of health screening questions prior to entry.
- The vaccination itself will only take a few moments but you will be required to stay on-site for 15-30 minutes afterwards for observation.

The 2nd dose will be administered at clinic on 3/25/21. An email will be sent out approximately 2 weeks prior to the 2nd dose date that will include scheduling instructions.

Limited availability

- *At this time there is limited supply of the vaccine.*
- *Please be patient. We know there are many more people who would like to be vaccinated than there is vaccine available.*
- *We will continue to notify residents of upcoming clinics and do our best to serve Sherburne County in a timely, efficient, and equitable manner.*

- You must have an appointment to attend a Sherburne County COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic. Do not come to clinic if you do not have an appointment.
